Star Words:



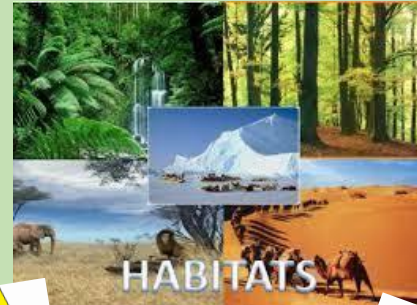
Continents, Europe, Africa, Asia, North America, South America, Australia, Antarctica.

Science:

We will be identifying different habitats from around the world and exploring the different types of animals that live there.

Habitat, micro habitat, adapted, polar, desert, rainforest, ocean, woodland.

Key Knowledge:

Identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited.

Other Curriculum Areas:

PE: games and First Aid

PSHE: What makes a good citizen?

DT: Using axles and wheels through making an aeroplane.

Art: Different art styles and artists from around the world with a focus on pointillism and Hubaina Limid.

RE: Leaders from different religions with a focus on Christianity.

Music: Learning how to play a tuned instrument (violins) and use their voices expressively by singing songs and speaking chants. They will also be learning about different instruments.
