We walked to school.

Mrs Harrison watched her favourite film.


Verbs can be <u>past tense</u> or <u>present tense</u>.

A present tense verb is an action that is happening now.

swallowing jumping shouting walking


A past tense verb is an action that is happened in the past.

swallowed jumped shouted walked

needed


Even though they might sound like 't', 'd' or 'id', they all end in 'ed'
