# What are our rules when using 'and' in a sentence?

- 1. 'and' brings two parts of a sentence together.
- 2. 'and' should only be used **once** in a sentence.
- 3. A comma is used **before** the word 'and'
- 4. 'and' is a co-ordinating conjunction.
