<u>Making a flower magazine</u>


Last year the year 1s made a flower book, to give to the new reception classes, to help them when looking for flowers in the playground.


You may have seen this book in your classroom

2. Fill in a flower fact file, try to choose a flower so it can be different to last week's one Here are some of last year's ones








